SMALL AND MARGINALIZED FARMERS:

We have been working with the small and marginalized farmers since once years. We are able to reached almost 40 small and marginalized farmers in Dhemaji district Assam till now. We have been giving them training on modern and scientific way of cultivation and produces more product and less risk during flood and non- flood season.

We are not only helping them in production but also we are connecting them with marketing to sell their products with good price. Now most of them are getting direct marketing and getting reasonable market price to sell their products and having better income and able to sustain themselves through farming.

Who has been farming and cultivating Vegetables like Peas, garlic, pumpkin, Mustard, cucumbers, bitter gourd etc in organic methods of cultivation. The Grace Trust have been giving him training on how to do the cultivation and proving the seeds and necesery tools for the farming. Now he is able to sustain himself by the farming and able to meet his family needs. And also we are giving him training on how cultivate and grow mushrooms' in the home itself.



Mr. Suren Khanikhar and Mr. Jatiram Dihingia from Chakala doloni Village, Dhemaji Assam are small and marginalized farmer who has been farming and cultivating Vegetables in 10 bigas of land like Long beans, pumpkin, Ladies figure, cucumbers, bitter gourd etc in organic methods of cultivation. Where this area is known for most flood affected areas of Dhemaji District Assam. The Grace Trust have been giving them training on how to do the cultivation and providing the seeds and necessary tools for the farming and also the marketing link to sell their product at best prices. Now he is able to sustain himself by the farming and able to meet his family needs. And also we are giving him training on how cultivate and grow mushrooms' in the home itself.
